Airport Commission:

The next scheduled Airport Commission meeting will be on Wednesday, the 10th of August in the Airport Terminal Building beginning at 5:30 PM. The Commission meetings are the second Wednesday of the month. Please notify us in advance if you need any special arrangements.

Parking Around The Airfield:

The area behind Hangar 37 is now a short term parking area for licensed Airport Operators only. This area is not to be used for long term parking. With the AvGas Self Fuel Station in use and jet parking in the area, we have changed the POV parking at the terminal. We are no longer allowing any automotive parking in the area marked "Aircraft Parking Only". If you need momentary access to the facilities inside (bathrooms) please use the area inside the fence by the back doors. Please remember this area is access for the Airport service trucks.
